Minutes of the 25th Meeting of the Board of Governors held on 18th November 2012

The 25th meeting of the Board of Governors of the Institute was held on November 18, 2012 at 12:30 pm in the Conference Room of NIT, Agartala.

The Chairman then invited the Director and the Registrar (I/C) to initiate discussion on agenda items.

Item No. 25.1: Confirmation of the Minutes of 24th Board of Governors Meeting.

The minutes of 24th Board of Governors meeting held on August 25th, 2012 were circulated to all Members for comments/observations. The Minutes of the 24th BOG meeting was confirmed.

Item No. 25.2: Action taken on the decision of the 24th meeting of the Board of Governors held on 25th August 2012.

The actions taken report were noted.

Item No. 25.3: To consider the minutes of 11th meeting of Senate of NIT Agartala held on 10-10-2012.

The BOG approved the minutes of 11th meeting of the Senate of National Institute of Technology Agartala, held on 10th October 2012.


In connection with Item No.S/11/50, the Chairman initiated the discussions. In this regard the Director, NIT Agartala, apprised the Board about the over-crowded classes and labs in Civil Engineering Department, which may lead to discontent among the students along with the dilution of academic standard. The number of teachers available is not enough to cater such huge number of students, which may lead to non-engagement of teacher in some cases.

However, it was pointed out that the actual annual intake in Civil Engineering and Civil and Transportation Engineering approved by the Board was only 120. Additional increase in intake strength has been on account of 27% increase under OBC quota by the MHRD. Any change in annual intake, therefore, needs the concurrence of MHRD. Further, the Civil Engineering discipline has the highest demand in the State of Tripura. This may create local discontent. Considering other related repercussions the Board requested the Senate to reconsider its decision under Item No.S/11/50 as regards to reduction of annual intake in B.Tech Civil Engineering from 184 to 150.

Item No. 25.4: To consider the recommendations of Interaction Meeting for appointment of Professor/Associate Professor and Sports Officer on contract basis at NIT, Agartala.

The recommendations made by the Interaction Committee in respect of selection of Professor/ Associate Professor and Sports Officer on contract basis held on 18th October 2012 at IIT Extension Centre, Salt Lake City, Kolkata were placed before the Board after

Addl. Item No. 25.8.1: To consider the Minutes of the 20th Finance Committee Meeting held on November 18, 2012.

Addl. Item No. 25.8.2: Resignation of Dr. Bindu Dey, Scientist 'G', Advisor of Biotechnology, Dept. of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, from the Board of Governors, NIT Agartala.

The Board was informed that Dr. Bindu Dey, Advisor of Biotechnology, Department of Biotechnology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Government of India, has tendered her resignation from the Membership of the Board of Governors of NIT Agartala due to paucity of time and work pressure. The Board resolved that a letter be addressed to Ministry of HRD informing about the resignation and nominate a person to replace Dr. Bindu Dey, Advisor of Biotechnology as Member of the BOG, NIT Agartala.

Addl. Item No.25.8.3: Issues related to service matters of Prof. Ajit Kumar Ray and Prof. Umesh Mishra.

The BOG was appraised about the action taken by the Director of NIT Agartala in the case of Prof. Ajit Kumar Ray and Prof. Umesh Mishra. The BOG asked the Director, NIT Agartala to take appropriate necessary steps in both the cases.

To prevent recurrence any such cases in future BOG resolved to constitute a committee under the Chairmanship of Prof. Nitindra Nath Som, Former Professor and Member, BOG, NITA. Director, Dean (Faculty Welfare), Dean (Administration), Dean (Academic) and the Registrar of NIT Agartala will be the Members of the Committee. This committee may co-opt other members if necessary. The committee will prepare a Check List and develop a mechanism to scrutinize the documents submitted by the candidates, on or before appearing for the interview and on or before joining the duty on selection.

The same committee will also review the matters related to Cumulative Professional Development Allowance (CPDA) and suggest method for proper and effective utilization of CPDA fund by the faculty members.
