The engagement of the Guest Faculty will be based on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The engagement shall be for teaching a course only with the following credit-based remuneration (honorarium): Rs. 25,000/- per credit/course

 (The above honorarium is fixed inclusive of all. No other expenses shall be borne by the Institute.)
- For each credit, a minimum of 13 one-hour classes shall be conducted by the faculty member. In addition, the faculty member is required to conduct class tests/provide assignments, prepare question papers for Mid-Term and End-Term examinations, and evaluate the answer scripts.
- 3. Payment of honorarium will be processed in three (03) phases. Completion of all academic requirements, including examinations and evaluation of answer scripts is mandatory.
- 4. Lectures shall be delivered in offline mode only. However, a maximum of one lecture hour per week may be conducted in online mode with prior approval.
- 5. The engagement shall be valid for at least one semester.
- 6. An individual can teach up to 15 credits.

Candidates are required to bring their original certificates and documents, along with self-attested photocopies, on the day of the interview. They should also submit an application on plain paper and a detailed bio-data including a recent photograph.

No TA/DA will be provided for attending the interview.
