- Annual Income of the family falls under BPL or Economic Weaker Section.
- Candidates must be willing to pursue/are pursuing:
 1. Academic & Professional Courses from Affiliated Institutions: Higher Secondary/ Graduate/Post-Graduate/Master/ Diploma etc
 2. Short-Term Skill Building & Certification Courses: Computer, Vocational, Hospitality etc.
 3. Coaching for Employment Oriented Govt Exams
- Course duration not extending beyond 31st March 2025.
